Oak Steakhouse

The brunch at Avalon's handsome steakhouse is special not just because of its modern, refined setting, but because the food and service are outstanding. For starters, order the flaky cinnamon rolls. Move on to poutine; the chunky house-made cheese curds and pork gravy ladled over crispy shoestring potatoes are heavenly. Don't bother to argue whether Oak Steakhouse has the best chicken and waffles in town – just order. Another star on the menu is the French toast made with a cinnamon raisin brioche, stuffed with apples and mascarpone, and then deep-fried.
